Instructions for Whip Checks

Whip checks are designed as safety restraints to prevent injury if a hose connection separates. They can be attached hose to hose or between a hose and another anchor point.

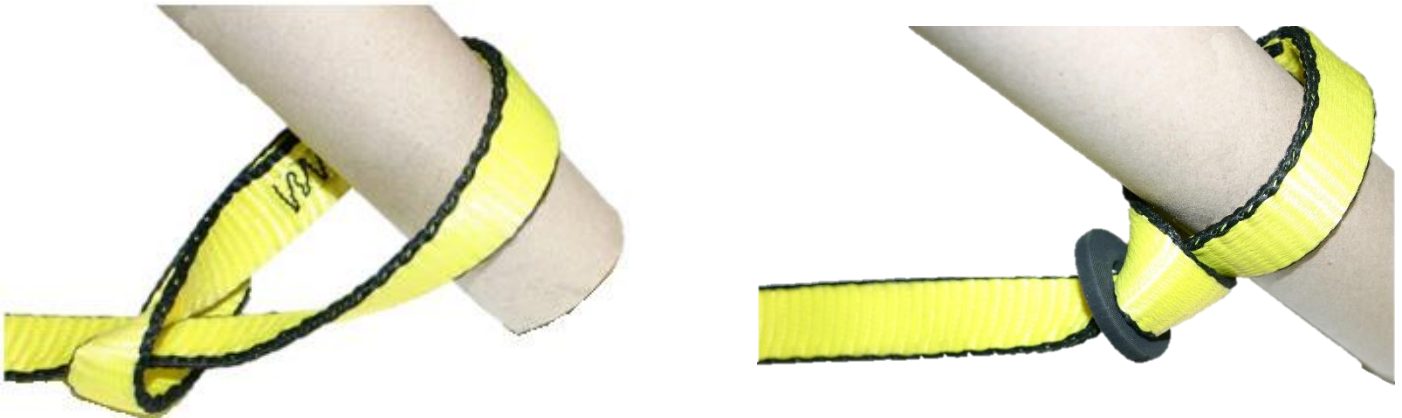

General Instructions

Whip checks do not require any tools for installation. Simply open the loop, slip it over the end of the hose and tighten it. Slide the rubber washer against the loop to hold the whip check in place.



Follow the same steps to attach the other end to a secure anchor point or another section of hose. After both loops are secured, move them away from each other so there is no slack in the whip check.
